There are few good things that can come out of the COVID19 pandemic, but one of them is the incredible community spirit among the people of Franschhoek.

People who in ordinary circumstances might never have met are working together and helping each other in many different ways. 'It is heartening the way people are pulling together' says Linda Coltart, one of the co-ordinators of the volunteer teams.. "We are getting to know each other better and understand each other's needs."

At places like soup kitchens (and there are now nine) they are not only producing thousand of healthy, tasty and nutritious meals, they are also educating children about the importance of using masks and the necessity of washing hands.

Dozens of people are now involved in fund raising, because food on this scale can be costly to produce. "But when the chips are down, we know we can rely on our amazing community to get involved" says Linda.
